

A free maths tutor your child can actually stick with

Dear Parent / Carer,

Your child's school is sharing this letter so you know about a free online maths tool that might help at home. It is called **MathsTutor.me**. It is not part of the school, and your child's teacher does not see what your child does on it.

MathsTutor.me covers the UK National Curriculum from KS1 (ages 5–7) all the way through to GCSE (age 16). Every child who signs up gets **two free lessons every single day, forever**. The two free lessons do not expire, no credit card is needed to begin, and there are no marketing follow-up emails.

The lessons work in your web browser on a phone, tablet, or laptop. Your child answers interactive questions, earns points for getting things right, and keeps a streak going for showing up each day. If they find something too easy or too hard, the app changes the difficulty to match.

If your child already uses MathsTutor.me, you are welcome to ignore this letter.

1. **Scan the QR code** with your phone's camera, or type **mathstutor.me** into your browser.
2. **Create a free account** using your email or a Google sign-in. It takes under a minute.
3. **Pick your child's year group** (Year 3, Year 7, whichever fits) so the first lessons land at the right level.
4. **Let them play for 10–15 minutes a day**. Two lessons a day are free, forever. Most children are happy to stop there.
